August brings some of Florida's hottest temperatures, frequent afternoon storms, and increased pool use. Follow these simple tips to keep your swimming pool, spa, or water feature operating safely and efficiently.

TEST YOUR WATER FREQUENTLY

Heavy rain and high temperatures can quickly affect your pool's chemistry. Regular water testing helps prevent algae, protects equipment, and keeps swimmers safe.

CHECK YOUR POOL AFTER EVERY STORM

Summer storms often leave behind leaves, dirt, and other debris. Empty skimmer baskets, remove debris from the pool, and inspect your equipment for proper operation.

MAINTAIN PROPER WATER LEVEL

Rainfall and evaporation can cause water levels to fluctuate. Keep the water at the proper level to ensure your skimmer and circulation system work efficiently.

KEEP WATER CIRCULATING

Run your pool pump daily to maintain proper filtration and circulation. Good circulation helps distribute chemicals evenly and reduces the chance of algae growth.

CLEAN YOUR FILTER

A clean filter improves water clarity, increases circulation, and reduces stress on your pool equipment. If your filter pressure is elevated, it may be time for a cleaning.

INSPECT YOUR EQUIPMENT

Listen for unusual noises, check for leaks, and verify that your pump, filter, heater, salt system, and automation equipment are operating correctly. Early detection can prevent costly repairs.
